- 1** Open a new UC Berkeley Student Checking account with at least \$20 from August 1 to September 28, 2018.
- 2** Download our App³ or visit bankofthewest.com and sign up for online banking.
- 3** Make five (5) purchases with your new debit card in the first calendar month of opening your account (on a boba run, snacks at GBC, you name it!) and the Amazon.com Gift Card is all yours.

The UC Berkeley Student Checking account has no monthly service charge, no minimum balance requirement and we have a branch and 16 ATMs right on campus.

A Bank of the West account is not required for any aspect of the Cal 1 Card or its debit feature.

¹The UC Berkeley Student Checking account offer is only available to UC Berkeley Students. A current Student Cal 1 Card, transcript, class schedule, or for incoming students an acceptance letter, must be presented at account opening. All accounts are subject to the Bank's standard Terms and Conditions and Schedule of Fees and Charges. Renew your UC Berkeley Student status before the 6-year anniversary of your account by presenting a valid UC Berkeley Student Cal 1 Card. Otherwise your account will be converted to our Any Deposit Checking account and the \$5 monthly Student Perks Bundle fee will no longer be waived.

²Requirements to receive a \$50 Amazon.com Gift Card

Open a new UC Berkeley Student Checking account at any branch between 8/1/18 and 9/28/18 with a minimum opening deposit of \$20 with funds new to Bank of the West ("Bank").

- Signup for online banking at bankofthewest.com from your computer or download our App on your mobile device. Wireless carriers may charge fees for text transmissions or data usage.
- UC Berkeley Student must request, receive and use a new Bank of the West Debit Card linked to the new UC Berkeley Student Checking account for five (5) or more debit card purchases (all of which must post to the account by the last business day of the month) in the month immediately following the opening deposit. See table below for details. Each purchase must be \$3 or more. ATM transactions are excluded.
- UC Berkeley Student Checking account must be in an open status and have a positive balance on the last day of the month that the debit card purchases must post to receive the Amazon.com Gift Card. See table below for details.
- UC Berkeley Student Checking account holder must have a valid email address on file at account opening.
- Amazon.com Gift Card will be emailed to the open UC Berkeley Student Checking primary account holder (using the email address on the Bank's records) based on the date the account was funded per the table below.

Amazon.com Gift Card Limitations

- Limit of one Amazon.com Gift Card bonus per UC Berkeley student.
- If the customer received or may receive any other consumer checking bonus from the Bank between 10/01/16 – 11/29/18 then they are not eligible for this offer.
- Offer not available to existing Bank of the West customers with an open checking account as of 7/31/2018.
- The Bank will classify the bonus as interest paid to the UC Berkeley Student Checking Account. Any applicable taxes associated with this offer are the responsibility of the account holder. To the extent required by law, the Bank will report total value of the offer to the IRS on Form 1099 for tax year 2018
